

Village of Corfu Budget Workshop Meeting, March 4, 2020

The Village of Corfu Board or Trustees held a Budget Workshop Meeting at the Corfu Village Hall, 116 East Main Street on March 4, 2020.

Mayor Tom Sargent opened the Budget workshop meeting at 6:30pm, followed by the Pledge of Allegiance.

Members present: Mayor Tom Sargent, Trustee Reisdorf, Trustee Lauer, Deputy Village Clerk, Jenny McMartin-Eck, and Village Clerk, Jennifer Eck. Deputy Mayor Al Graham arrived at the meeting at 7:05pm Trustee Doktor was absent.

The Board reviewed a copy of the 2020-2021 proposed budget to review. Mayor Sargent stated he would like to see a monthly financial report per dept.

Mayor Sargent presented the proposed Police Budget to include wage information, expenses. (see attached). Each member received a copy.

Mayor Sargent would like to start a reserve line for a police vehicle.

The village may have to hire new officer/officers if Dave Krzemien get elected to the Genesee County Sheriffs position.

Crossing guard and Traffic Control was discussed. Trustee Lauer asked if the village needs to pay Crossing Guard Charlie Lenhard the four (4) hour minimum per NYS Labor Laws.

Deputy Clerk Jenny McMartin-Eck will contact the Dept of Labor to inquire.

Mayor Sargent stated there are 22 concerts planned for Darien Lake to date and more could be scheduled.

Some discussion on building a locker room for the officers at the garage, \$5000.00 was budgeted for this.

Deputy Mayor Al Graham made a motion to adjourn the budget workshop meeting, 2nd by Trustee Reisdorf. Meeting closed at 7:55pm.
